Step 2: Know the Dealing Process

Once all bets are placed, the dealer will deal two cards each to both the Player and the Banker hands. These cards are dealt face up.

- If either hand has a total of 8 or 9 (known as a “natural”), the game round ends immediately, and the hand with the higher total wins.
- If no natural appears, the game may proceed with a third card deal, but the rules for when a third card is drawn are automatic and fixed by the casino, meaning players do not make that decision.

Step 3: Third Card Rules Simplified

Understanding the third card rules is crucial, although in most online versions this is handled automatically:

- If the Player's total is 0-5, the Player draws a third card.
- If the Player stands (has 6 or 7), the Banker draws a third card if the Banker's total is 0-5.
- If the Player draws a third card, the Banker's decision to draw depends on the Banker's total and the Player's third card value.

Though these rules may sound complicated at first, the good news is you don't have to memorize them when playing online since the system deals cards automatically. However, knowing these rules helps you understand the flow of the game.

Step 4: Calculate the Winning Hand

After the cards are dealt, the hand with the closest total to 9 wins. Here's how the winner is determined:

- If the Player's total is higher than the Banker's, Player bets win.
- If the Banker's total is higher than the Player's, Banker bets win.
- If both hands have the same total, Tie bets win.

Payouts generally work like this:

- Winning Player bet pays 1:1
- Winning Banker bet pays 0.95:1 (due to commission)
- Winning Tie bet pays 8:1 or sometimes 9:1 depending on the casino rules

Step 5: Manage Your Bankroll Wisely

One of the most important factors for beginners is money management. Baccarat, like all gambling games, carries risk. Setting a budget before you start playing helps you avoid losses beyond what you can afford.
